#### **Lesson: Comparing Things (Comparative Adjectives)**

page of this lesson plan for word cards During class: Scatter the objects / photos / flashcards randomly around the classroom (eg under tables, stuck to walls, on bookshelves, etc) Students are going to match word cards to the objects around the room (see last page of this lesson plan for word cards) Put students into pairs or small groups
